Hello Firefly Tennis Families,

Please take a moment to review the important information listed here. Since we are a sports-based program, this will be one of the safest summer activities for your children. We will all work together to keep everyone safe this summer!

We will continue to maintain a student to instructor ratio of 6:1 or better and in addition to our team of instructors we also hired another staff member who will solely focus on sanitation on and off the court and remind kids of safe practices.

The entire team has been trained on basic principles of emergency first aid, proper hand washing/sanitizing practices, and proper use of PPE. They are also up to date with all COVID-19 signs and symptoms.

Symptoms related to COVID-19 include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue, muscle or body aches
- Headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
- Loss of taste or smell

All players and staff will have their temperature checked upon arrival to the courts and if anyone shows a fever of 100.4F or higher, or other signs of COVID-19 illness, they will not be admitted on the property. We encourage all families to be alert and immediately let us know if you think there are any symptoms of illness at home.

SOCIAL DISTANCING of at least 6ft will be maintained at all times. Staff members will only approach a child in case there is a need for assistance. If this occurs, the staff member will wear proper PPE: face mask and gloves.

FACE MASKS and GLOVES will be mandatory for our staff members if they have to break the 6ft distance. Children are not required to wear face masks during play since we are going to be outdoors in the summer heat. Children will be required to wear face masks when going indoors for bathroom use or in case of inclement weather.

HAND WASHING AND SANITIZING will be mandatory for all participants upon arrival and will be repeated very often throughout the day. Children will disinfect their hands under direct supervision from our staff members.

BAHTROOM USE will be limited to only one person at a time. Hand washing will be mandatory before exiting the bathroom. As a double layer of protection, a staff member will make sure each child also uses hand sanitizer upon exiting the bathroom.

GROUPS of children will stay together and will interact with the same instructor the entire week. Direct contact with other groups will not be allowed any out-of-group interaction will be minimized.

EQUIPMENT used during the day will be replaced in the evening with new or disinfected equipment. Groups will not share any equipment during the day. In case a child needs to borrow a racquet, it will be disinfected.



DROP OFF and PICK UP: Children will walk to the courts while maintaining a distance of at least 6ft and visitors/parents/guardians must stay in their cars. Our staff will guide and walk the children to their designated areas. Please see the link with directions in the welcome e-mail.

BREAKS: Each group will have a designated area where they can rest in the shade and will not share that space with another group. Children will have enough space to spread out during their breaks.

FOOD: We are not offering any food items and children cannot share any food.

Please make sure to pack more food and snacks than you think your child needs.

WATER: Children must bring a large water container of at least 32oz. We will have sealed water bottles available if they need more during the day.

EDUCATION: Staff members will educate children on sports etiquette regarding social distancing and hygiene. Children will be shown alternatives to high-fives and handshakes.

WEATHER: We are going to be an outdoor-only program this year. In case of inclement weather, everyone will take shelter with their masks on until parents arrive for pick up.

MAKE UPS: Only if the camp day is completely cancelled, you will receive a credit valid until September 30th to be used for any type of lessons. No partial rain day credits offered.
